INSTRUCTIONS TO KNOW MEASURE OF A RING


IMPORTANT: To use this sheet, you must follow the following steps:

- Before printing; File> Print> Page scaling> None> OK.
- After printing check with a ruler that the square on the left is $3 \mathrm{~cm} . t$
- SIf the square does not measure $3 \times 3 \mathrm{~cm}$, you will have misplaced the meter. Reprint the sheet and make sure that "Page scaling" is "None".
- Once the page is printed, you can choose between the two methods we present below. Being that Method A the most reliable.

METHOD A:
Place the ring on top of the circles, until the ring fits perfectly with one of them. If in doubt, take the largest shape.

Here we present you with a scale of numbers corresponding to the diameter of the rings. The space to measure is exactly the space inside the ring, as you can see in the diagram on the right.


METHOD B:


Trim the next meter by the edge and cut on the dotted line titled "cut here". Set the meter to the knuckle you are measuring and pull firmly until it is snug to your finger.

Record the measure that protrudes from the meter.
The engagement ring is usually worn on the ring finger, which is next to the pinky finger.
